About the University of Rajasthan, Jaipur:

The University of Rajasthan is the oldest institution of higher education in Rajasthan. It was established on 8th January, 1947, as the University of Rajputana (Renamed as the University of Rajasthan in the year 1956) with the main objective of disseminating knowledge and catering to the needs of the students of Rajasthan. It is the hub of Higher Education in Rajasthan paving the way for the other universities. It attracts students from all over Rajasthan and other parts of India and abroad. It is a multi-faculty University and is recognized under 2 (f) and 12B of U.G.C. since its inception. It has 36 Post Graduate Departments, 15 recognized Research Centers, 6 Constituent Colleges. The University of Rajasthan has been accredited as A+ University by NAAC up to 2009.

About Jaipur (Pink City):

Jaipur, popularly known as the Pink City and State Capital of Rajasthan was founded in 1727, AD by one of the greatest rulers of the Kachhawaha clan, the astronomer kind Sawai Jai Singh. It was designed by the brilliant architect Vidyadhar Battacharya. This remarkable city is enameling, tie and dye, stone carving, pottery and miniature painting. The old city is still coloured in pink so it is known as Pink City. It is well connected from all the places in India by road, railways and airport. It is 270 kms. away from Capital of India-New Delhi, 230 Kms. away from Taj Mahal City, Agra and 170 Kms. away from Ajmer City of Khwaja Ji and Pushkar Raj.

Jaipur is very popular place for tourists' point of view. There are hundreds of beautiful temples giving Jaipur its unique charm and it is also well known for its monuments and forts. To mention a few, **Ganesh temple** (Moti Doongari), Laxmi Narayan temple- **Birla Mandir** is just adjoining to the University and Jawahar Circle Garden (the biggest garden) are just 5 Kms. away (South) from the University on same route towards Chokhi Dhani. Stature Circle, Central Park, **Assembly Hall**, Shahid Smark, Birla Planetariums, Ram Bag Place etc. are also 5 Kms. away (west) from the University.

Govind Dev Ji temple, Hawa Mahal (having 953 windows), Albert Hall (Museum), City Palace (Museum), Sarga Suli, **Jantar-Mantar (World Heritage)**, Raj Mandir (Picture Hall), all in walled Pink City are just 5 Kms. away (North) from the University. Galta Ji (religious place) Sisodiya Rani Garden, Vidhyadhar Ka Bag on Agra Road almost 12 Kms. from the University.
